

## APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS U.S. Citizens and Permanent Residents

Application Deadline: *January 15*

*To assure prompt processing of your application, please follow these instructions carefully.*

*Collect and mail all of the following materials in one packet to:*

**NOTE:** *Sending these materials by fax is not acceptable.*

- **Application for Graduate Admission.** Original and two copies of the Application for Graduate Admission form.
- **Fee.** A nonrefundable application fee of \$50, check or money order in U.S. dollars payable to Oregon State University.
- **Transcripts.** Three photocopies of all official transcripts (not grade slips or reports) of previous academic work, undergraduate and graduate. Transcripts showing the last 90 quarter (60 semester) credit hours of graded work of the first baccalaureate degree must be included. All graduate and postbaccalaureate transcripts must be included. (If the applicant is admitted, two official transcripts from the above institutions must be received by the Office of Admission and Orientation prior to the student's second term of registration.)
- **Statement of Objectives.** Two copies of your statement of objectives and particular fields of interest. Short personal statement of your graduate study objectives and your particular field of interest within Electrical and Computer Engineering.
- **Recommendation Letters.** Three letters of reference from people familiar with your technical abilities (former professors or employers, etc.) on the **School's** reference form. Other reference letters should be written on official letterhead. Applicants with a master's degree should include a letter from their major professor. Recommenders should seal their letters in letterhead envelopes, if possible, sign across the seal and return them to you for inclusion with your application packet. Recommenders who choose to submit their letters directly to the **School of EECS** should be reminded of the **application deadline**.

- **Research Interest Questionnaire.** Form is required by department to identify your primary areas of interest. The primary areas are: Communications, signal processing & controls; Computer Engineering; Electronics; Energy Systems; Materials and Devices; Microwaves and Optics. You can indicate up to 3 primary areas ---rank them from 1-3. Within each primary group please mark all areas that interest you.
- **Graduate Record Examination (GRE).** GRE score usually not required. If required, photocopy of GRE score report required initially. Official GRE score is required if applicant is accepted by EECS. The GRE is required of students who graduated from a non-US institution, from a BS program other than EECS, or from a non-ABET-accredited ECE program. The GRE score can be no more than 5 years old at the time of applicant's first term of registration.
- **Additional Information.** Any other data you think would be helpful in making an evaluation of your application
