- Structured like a start-up weekend/hackathon
- Students work in teams to build a new piece of technology in 30-hours

- Students on average, more mature, more driven

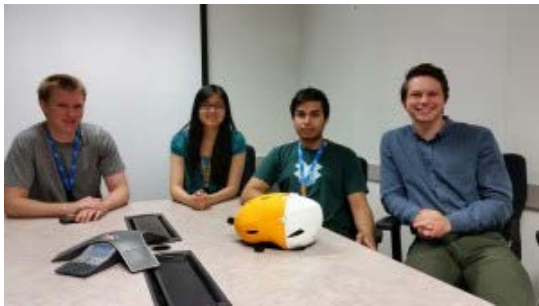
